Spanish Curriculum Overview (KS2)

Following the National Curriculum & Delivered Using Language Angels

At our school, all Key Stage 2 pupils (Years 3–6) receive a weekly Spanish lesson, using the fully compliant and structured **Language Angels** scheme of work. Intent

Implementation

Progression Overview

Children will:

Year 3–4 (Lower KS2)

- Engage in basic conversations and present simple information.
- Develop accurate pronunciation and start reading and writing short sentences.

Year 5-6 (Upper KS2)

- Speak and write using a broader range of vocabulary and structures.
- Ask and answer more complex questions, express opinions, and describe people and places.
- Read and understand longer texts and adapt phrases to write their own.
- Deepen grammar understanding (e.g. verb conjugation, gender agreement).

Impact

By the end of KS2, pupils will be able to:

- Communicate effectively in Spanish for practical purposes.
- Demonstrate understanding of basic grammar rules.

- Show curiosity about Spanish-speaking cultures.
- Feel confident and prepared for language learning at KS3.
