# Year 2 Summer newsletter

Dear Parents,


Thank you for your support so far this year. The children are working hard and are making great progress in Year 2. As we enter our final term, your continued support is more important than ever. Parental support and involvement is vital in Year 2, so here is a summary of what will be covered in class during the Summer term so you can support your child at home.

#### **ENGLISH**

During Summer 1, we will be continuing to focus on sentence structure and using conjunctions to extend our writing. We will be reading The day the Crayons Quit to help us write a letter. We will continue to develop our spelling skills and work on our handwriting, with a focus on using cursive to join letters neatly and consistently.

We will be taking part in a Poetry Week where children will explore and enjoy a range of poems. As a class, we will practise and perform a poem together

In Summer 2 we will be reading Supertato. Children will identify and use the key features of instructions to help them write their own.





# MATHS

In the Summer term we will be continuing to focus on arithmetic skills throughout this term and we will be completing weekly arithmetic lessons to revise the five areas of arithmetic we have studied so far: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and fractions.

In addition to this, children will focus on quick recall of multiplication and division facts for 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

During Summer 2, children will be focusing on measurement including mass, capacity and temperature. After this, we will be focusing on statistics.

Children will also be learning about position and direction.

# RE

We continue to follow the Archdiocese of Birmingham RE strategy.

Year 2 will be learning about the Church and the special signs and symbols which we use to pray. We will be looking in detail at the Mass and how we feel when we come together as God's family. We will be practising the responses so we can try to join in more when we attend Mass.

Throughout the year, children will continue to attend Mass on a Wednesday and prayer services in school. Children will continue with daily Collective Worship opportunities in school and will have the opportunity to plan and lead these themselves within their class.



#### GEOGRAPHY and HISTORY

In Geography, we will explore climate and weather. Children will learn the difference between the two and how the poles and equator affect Earth's climate. They will carry out simple fieldwork, and collect, record, and analyse weather data.

In Summer 2 children will be learning about how technology has changed our lives. Children will place events and artefacts on a timeline and use evidence to ask and answer questions about the past. They will explore why certain technologies were invented, how they have changed over time, and what has stayed the same.

#### COMPUTING

Children will continue to develop their understanding of simple computer programming using Purple Mash. We will be focusing on creating pictures.

Before using technology, children are always reminded of internet safety rules.

This term we will be focusing on using a range of Purple Mash programmes and we will be improving our computer literacy skills with a special focus on presenting ideas.



#### PE

This term in PE, we will be learning key skills including hitting, catching, and running as they develop their coordination and teamwork.

We will also be incorporating active Maths and English into our PE lessons to make learning fun and physically engaging.

### SCIENCE

During the Summer term, we will begin our new unit on Plants.

We will explore how plants grow from seeds and bulbs, learning that these contain stored food to help them begin to grow. We will investigate the conditions plants need to grow well, such as water, light, and warmth. As part of our learning, we will carry out an investigation and observe the different stages of plant growth. We will also discover how plants reproduce. Throughout the unit, we will continue to develop our scientific vocabulary and strengthen our ability to think and work scientifically.

#### ART and D+T

As part of our Art this half term, children will be learning about sculpture. We will be learning how artists have been inspired by castles.

In Summer 2 we will be designing, making and evaluating pizzas!

# At home

Homework is set via Purple Mash every Friday. Please make sure that this is completed by the following Thursday.

It is important that children read at home daily and bring their book bag into school each day so they can also read with a teacher. Children will bring home a book each week: which will be the phonics book they access in school.

During the Summer term PE lessons will take place every Tuesday and Thursday.

Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing their PE kit on these days and that any earrings have been removed.

Please note, all children must be wearing the correct school shoes and not trainers. If there is anything you are unsure about, please do not hesitate to have a chat with us at 3.30pm.
