Dear Parents,



ENGLISH

Geography

We will learn about the land use in Erdington and how this has changed over time.




SCIENCE

The children will be learning about Light this term.

We will be learning about how light travels and reflective surfaces.

We will also look at what we need to use to protect us from UV light.



COMPUTING

This term we will be learning how to type more effectively through a unit of work on Touch Typing
Throughout this we will constantly be learning how to use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly. Giving the children the ability to recognise acceptable/unacceptable behaviour on-line so they can identify a range of ways to report concerns about content and contact.

Children will be working on two strands of the PE curriculum this term.

Tennis- where they will learn skills of ball and racquet control and footwork.

ART

Year 3 will be learning about Chromatic Art. Children will be learning how to use water colours correctly to paint life images.
